

Memory Verses: Elevate Your Relationship with God

Beginnings: The Bible's fantastic four

1. Genesis 1:1 – In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
2. John 1:1 – In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
3. John 1:14 – The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory as the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
4. John 3:16 – For God so loved the world He gave His One and Only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.
 - a. John 3:17 – For God did not send his son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

The Roman Road: The Plan of Salvation

5. Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
6. Romans 6:23 – For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
7. Romans 5:8 – But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us!
8. Romans 10:9 – If you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
9. Romans 10:10 – For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Listening: The Word of God and Prayer

- 10.2 Timothy 3:16 – All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness,
 - a. 2 Timothy 3:17 – so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
11. Joshua 1:8 – This book of instruction must not depart from your mouth; you are to recite it day and night, so that you may carefully observe everything in it. For then you will prosper and succeed in whatever you do.

12. Psalm 119:11 – I have hidden Your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.
13. Deuteronomy 6:6 – These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart.
14. Deuteronomy 6:7 – Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
15. Hebrews 4:12 (NIV) – For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
16. Hebrews 4:16 (NIV) – Let us then approach God’s throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
17. 1 John 5:14 – Now this is the confidence we have before Him: whenever we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.
18. 1 John 5:15 – And if we know that He hears whatever we ask, we know that we have what we have asked Him for.

Assurance: Inner Peace and Security

19. 1 John 5:11 – And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his son.
20. 1 John 5:12 – Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the son of God does not have life.
21. John 14:1 – Your heart must not be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in Me.
22. John 14:2 – In my Father’s house are many dwelling places; if not, I would have told you. I am going away to prepare a place for you.
23. John 14:3 – If I go away and prepare a place for you, I will come back and receive you to Myself, so that where I am you may be also.
24. John 14:6 – Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”
25. John 14:27 – Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Your heart must not be troubled or fearful.
26. Isaiah 26:3 – You will keep in perfect peace the mind that is dependent on You, for it is trusting in You.

27. Isaiah 53:5 – But He was pierced because of our transgressions, crushed because of our iniquities; punishment for your peace was on Him, and we are healed by His wounds.
28. Isaiah 53:6 – We all went astray like sheep; we all have turned to our own way; and the Lord has punished Him for the iniquity of us all.

Praise: Worship and Thanksgiving

29. 1 Peter 1:3 – Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. In His great mercy, He has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.
30. Psalm 100:4 – Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him and praise His name.
31. Psalm 100:5 – For the Lord is good and His love is eternal; His faithfulness endures through all generations.
32. Revelation 4:11 – Our Lord and God, You are worthy to receive glory and honor and power, because you have created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.

Promises: Verses to Stand On

33. Matthew 6:33 – But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
34. Romans 8:28 – And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.
35. Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”
36. 1 John 1:7 – But if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
37. 1 John 1:9 – If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
38. Proverbs 3:5 – Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;
39. Proverbs 3:6 – in all your ways submit to him, and He will make your paths straight.

40. 1 Corinthians 10:13 – No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to humanity. And God is faithful; He will not let you to be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.
41. Psalms 55:22 – Cast your burden on the Lord, and He will sustain you; He will never allow the righteous to be shaken.
42. 1 Peter 5:7 – Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.

Holiness: Obeying God's Commands

43. 2 Chronicles 7:14 – If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and heal their land.
44. Romans 12:1 - Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.
45. Romans 12:2 - Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.
46. Romans 12:11 – Do not lack diligence; be fervent in spirit; serve the Lord.
47. Romans 12:12 – Rejoice in hope; be patient in affliction; be persistent in prayer.
48. Romans 12:18 – If possible, on your part, live at peace with everyone.
49. 2 Corinthians 9:7 - Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
50. Hebrews 10: 24-25 - ²⁴And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
51. Proverbs 1:7 – The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
52. Proverbs 15:1 – A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs up wrath.
